Lent Course.

The local Churches Together five-week series of Lent Talks/Discussions continues this Tuesday 10th March at 7.00pm in our own Hall. All are welcome to any of these talks.

CAFOD Family Fast.

We will take up the Family Fast Collection today. This year's Family Fast has had the theme of "Your love expressed through our hands" and is focused on support to new mothers in underdeveloped countries. £6 could train two mums to set up a support group on breastfeeding and weaning & £20 could train three health workers to check babies for malnutrition.

Corona Virus. In recent weeks parishes have been receiving advice on measures to be taken as a consequence of the Corona Virus. At the time of writing the advice can be summarised as follows:

- i) Good hand hygiene. Please thoroughly wash your hands at home before leaving for Church. Could those cleaning church give special attention to door handles/door plates and pew surfaces.
- ii) At this time there is no need to withdraw the sign of peace or the chalice. However, individuals may wish to abstain from these. If advised to suspend the chalice and sign of peace this can be simply implemented.
- iii) It would be wiser to receive Holy Communion on the hand not on the tongue during this time. If the chalice is withdrawn it will only be possible to receive the host on the hand and Holy Water stoups emptied.
- iv) Those with health concerns related to the Virus should stay at home.
