# Parliamentary Votes Concerning Abortion.

The Report Stage of the Criminal Justice Bill is taking place this **Wednesday 15 May**. MPs will be given the opportunity to vote on two pro-life changes to the law:

- i) An amendment tabled by Caroline Ansell MP lowers the abortion time limit from 24 weeks to 22 weeks.
- ii) An amendment tabled by Liam Fox MP, to bring the abortion time limit for babies with Down's syndrome in line with the time limit for babies that do not have disabilities (currently abortion for Down's syndrome is currently legal right up to birth).
