Next Sunday we will have the annual collection to support the work of Catholic Care, our diocesan agency which works with children in care, families with difficulties and challenges, people with disabilities and the care of the elderly. A limited number of their annual report for 2019 and Gift Aid envelopes are available at the back of church.

Corona Virus

It is time to increase the provisions being made to combat the spread of the Corona Virus. Bishop Marcus has put the following arrangements in place until Sunday 19th April (the Sunday after Easter Sunday):

- i) Communion from the Chalice and the Sign of Peace will be suspended
- ii) All communicants are encouraged to receive Holy Communion in the hand and not on the tongue during this period. Those who wish to continue receiving on the tongue are asked to come for Holy Communion after other communicants. Clergy and ministers are advised to avoid contact with the communicants' hands (and tongues) during this time.
- iii) Holy Water stoups are to be emptied, the use of hymnbooks discontinued replaced by the use of single use hymn sheets and arrangements made for the collection which avoids passing the collection plate among the congregation.
- iv) Good hand hygiene. Please thoroughly wash your hands at home before leaving for Church. Could those cleaning church give special attention to door handles/door plates and pew surfaces.
- v) Those with health concerns related to the Virus should stay at home.
