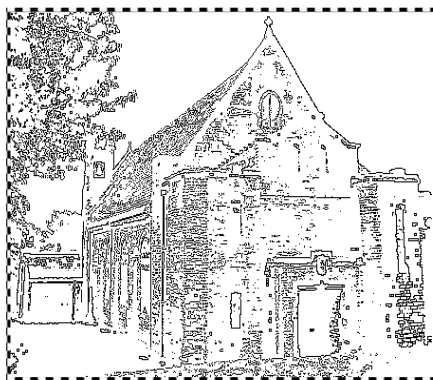

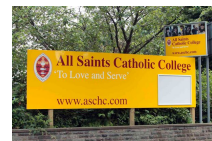

He then announced that he is accepting in full, with no changes, the preferred option, submitted by the Deanery, for the re-organisation of Parishes. He went on to say he will announce the plan for the "deployment" of 5 priests in the Deanery at the beginning of July and that the changes should be completed in September 2016. He encouraged us to pray that the Catholic communities of Calderdale would continue to spread the Good News with great joy.
