Sacrament of First Confession. ## **Sacrament Of Confirmation.**

Bishop Marcus will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2018 at Sacred Heart Church, Sowerby Bridge. Those young people in school years 7 & 8 who wish to be confirmed should make themselves known to Fr Michael if they have not already done so.
