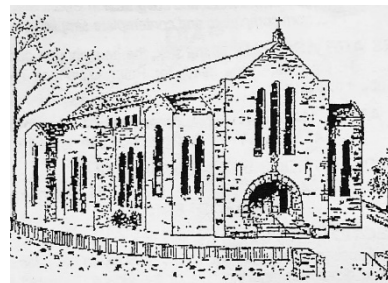

Celebration of Mass by Bishop Marcus
Monday 9.30pm. Holy Hour & Torchlight Procession
Tuesday 3.00pm. Anointing of the Sick
Tuesday 4.00pm. Holy Hour & Blessing of the Sick

The Life Transfigured series exploring Faith & the Arts have organised two talks for September:

- i. Tue 13 Sep **Faith, Music & the Big Screen** (Benson Taylor & Sir John Battle) 7-8pm, Wheeler Hall, Leeds Cathedral. Benson Taylor is an electronic music composer, DJ and record producer and winner of Best Original Music at the Monaco International Film Festival. His recent soundtrack commissions include the film adaptation of the Martin Amis' thriller London Fields. He will be discussing faith, music and the big screen with fellow Yorkshireman, veteran politician and campaigner, Sir John Battle.
- ii. Tue 20 Sep **Art and God** (Patrick van der Vorst) 7-8pm, Hinsley Hall. Former director of Sotheby's London and previous winner of BBC's Dragon Den, Patrick is an art expert and entrepreneur. Now training for the priesthood, Patrick has kindly offered to talk to us about Art illuminating our encounter with God and his web-based project which uses art to reflect on the daily Gospel readings.
