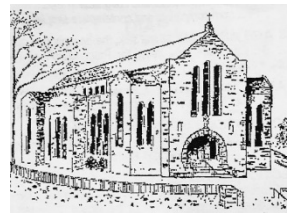

He had served at St Malachy's from 1999 to 2016 and for a further three years he served in St Patrick's parish in Elland. His body will be received into St Malachy's Church on Tuesday 16th July at 6.30pm and Mass will follow. His Requiem Mass will take place the following day, Wednesday 17th July, at 12noon followed by interment, close to his brother Fr Michael Nealon, in Queensbury Cemetery.
