#### Private Visits to a Church.

Locally the clergy are working together to ensure that each day there is access to St Mary's church with complimentary provision around the town. Throughout the period when no public liturgies are taking place private visits to pray before the Blessed Sacrament, light candles, make the Stations of the Cross can be made as follows:

Daily at St Mary's Church, Gibbet Street, between 10am and 12noon.

**St Columba's Church.** The church will be open on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons between 2pm and 4pm. On Sundays the church will be open between 10.00am and 12noon

**St Malachy's Church**. Access to the church during daylight hours will be available through the side door of the church controlled by a coded lock. Fr Michael & Sr Anne will share this code with parishioners who wish to make visits who should not pass this on. Here candles *should not* be left lit to reduce a fire hazard. Please ensure the door is always locked behind you. On Sundays the church will be open between 10.00am and 12noon

On these visits to the church it is requested that people maintain the current norms of social distancing.
