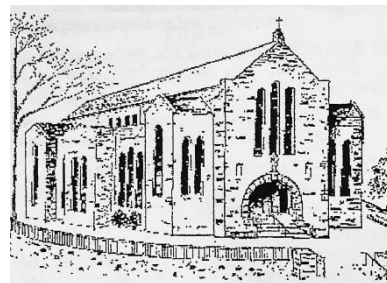

Covid Pandemic Adjustments following July 19th

Following the changes in legislation on July 19th our Church life will evolve as follows:

Please continue:

- i. To leave your details online or in the church porch or scan the QR code for track & trace
- ii. To sanitize your hands on arrival & departure
- iii. To wear a face covering while rates of infection are high; *many parishioners have indicated that they feel this is important for them to feel safe in church*
- iv. To use the "X" cards to indicate where you have been seated and to sanitize the church after use
- v. To leave every second row vacant

Changes

- i. Singing is permitted but we are asked to phase it in slowly over the summer period and face coverings are to be worn while singing
- ii. We will begin re-using the Lectionary instead of single sheet papers. Readers are asked to use the sanitizer provided before and after reading
- iii. Votive candles in the side chapels are being made available

The 11am Mass will return to St Columba's Church **next Sunday 8th August**. Only every second row will be used, face coverings should be worn, and communion will be distributed in your places.
