## Fourteenth Sunday of the Church's Year

### St Columba's and St Malachy's re-open for the celebration of Mass.

Fr. Michael writes. As we open our churches for the celebration of Mass we must both ensure the safety of all and enable the maximum number of parishioners to have the opportunity to attend the celebration of Mass. The 2 metre social distancing rule remains in place. The two churches I serve are very different and I propose to start with the celebration of five Masses weekly using the larger church of St Malachy's for the three weekend Masses and the smaller church of St Columba for two midweek celebrations. Sunday obligation remains suspended and parishioners need to choose carefully which Mass they attend. As many as 90 people may be able to attend any of the Masses at St Malachy's; some may prefer to join a smaller number of 24 people at St. Columba's. Parishioners should not attend Mass if they have Covid symptoms or are particularly vulnerable. In order to attend Mass a place has to be booked and we have to keep a record of who attends Mass together with their contact details for 21 days which would be used by "Track and Trace" if required. These details will be taken at the time of Bookings should preferably be made through the website booking. (www.stcolumbascatholicchurch.com) once the system is installed early this week. Those without internet access should ring Fr Michael on 361682 being careful to leave their name and phone number and the Mass they wish to attend in any The booking system needs to be reasonably flexible to reflect the different sized groups in which parishioners come to church and so each ticket refers to a space which includes social distance -one ticket will accommodate a single person or a couple; two tickets will accommodate a family group. There is no need to reserve more than two tickets to reserve an appropriate space for your family.

Parishioners at St Columba's may be disappointed that Sunday Mass cannot be recommenced immediately at St Columba's but we will return there for Sunday Mass when social distancing requirements make it possible. In the meantime, I ask parishioners of St Columba's to provide the reader, minister and stewards for the Sunday 11.00am. at St Malachy's.

**Volunteers as stewards/sanitizers.** We need to build up the number of those available for helping as stewards/sanitizers. As Mass resumes duties will be wrapped around the Mass you are attending, and the commitment will involve arriving early for stewarding

duties and remaining after Mass to sanitize the areas that have in use. Please let Fr. Michael know if you can assist with this critical service.
