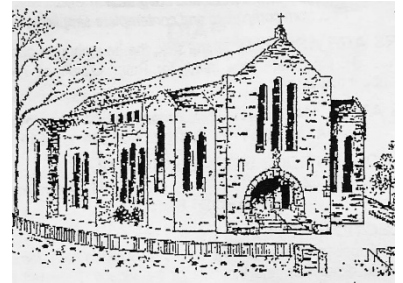

Timing of Saturday evening Mass.
