



 - iii. 19 preferred a 5.30pm start
- iv. 3 people preferred either a 5.00pm or 5.30pm start
 - v. 12 preferred a 6.00pm start.

Therefore, we will celebrate Saturday Evening Mass at **5.00pm** starting Saturday **30**th **October** (the weekend the clocks go back)

The Assisted Dying Bill

will receive its Second Reading, with full debate, this Friday 22nd October. It aims to legalise assisted suicide in England and Wales. If successful it will permit a terminally adult who has less than 6 months to live, to be assisted in ending their life. The Church is clear that assisted suicide is a crime against human life; Pope Francis has said, 'Physician-assisted suicide is part of a 'throwaway culture' that offers a 'false compassion' and treats a human person as a problem...True compassion does not marginalise anyone, nor does it humiliate and exclude- much less considers the disappearance of a person as a good thing.

Please pray for the defeat of this bill.
