

St. Bernadette's Relics will visit Leeds Cathedral from 6.30pm on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> October to 5.00pm the following day. The highlights of the programme at the Cathedral are:

> Monday 7.00pm & Tuesday 12.30pm. Celebration of Mass by Bishop Marcus Monday 9.30pm. Holy Hour & Torchlight Procession Tuesday 3.00pm. Anointing of the Sick Tuesday 4.00pm. Holy Hour & Blessing of the Sick
